

## Minutes of Nokomis ATV Club

**Elections in June and Bylaw Changes:** There was a motion by Dave Ebben to create a Membership Secretary position, second by Randy Myre. Motion carried.

Changes to the Bylaws, will include the Membership Secretary also 2yr terms for all officer positions alternating. This year it will be President, Secretary and Membership Secretary, along with two board positions
