Discussions:

Gladi gave a Christmas Party update. Party will be at the Prairie Rapids Pavilion on December 4<sup>th</sup>. Pizzas will be purchased from Billy Bob's and Twin Bay. Drink tickets will be good for up to \$4 drink. Three \$25 gift certificates will be given away.

Rita gave financial report. Annual party and cash raffle made about \$6,200. We discussed upcoming expenses for 2022. It was suggested that it would be a good idea to have a budget sheet showing reoccurring expenses. Rita will send out \$50 checks to the 3 land owners as done in the past. Discussed again donating to food pantry if there is a need.

Brief discussion of next fund raiser. Unanimous agreement that it should be some type of cash raffle--- bigger than the one we did this year. Larry will make it the #1 item to be discussed at the April meeting.

Discussed the membership letter going out to businesses requiring them to join by January 31 in order to be on the trail map. Vickie has rough draft of letter. Letter will go out mid December.

Gregg will stop at Pine Point and pick up map box if they are not going to renew their membership.

Discussed keeping Go Daddy or going with knew Web service. Our 3 year contract with Go Daddy is up in about 6 months. Larry will talk with Kari Kelley (Chamber office) after the first of the year to get more information on her services and compare prices.

Larry gave update on Cruisers trail. DNR has approved plans. Bids are being posted and will be opened on December 15<sup>th</sup>. Larry will see if he can find out where bids are being posted. He will also put something out on our website. Hopefully tree cutting, etc. can be started this spring. Suggestion that we put some type of Nokomis ATV Club sign on each end of the trail when completed.

Was agreed that we should continue the 50/50 raffle, coffee and donuts and gift certificate drawing at monthly meetings.

Discussion of how to promote our club more by perhaps getting more involved in community sponsored events such as the 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade and the venison feed. Should we consider having an ad in the WATVA? Because Grant will be taking over as President as was not able to attend the meeting, further discussion on this topic will be postponed until our next meeting.
